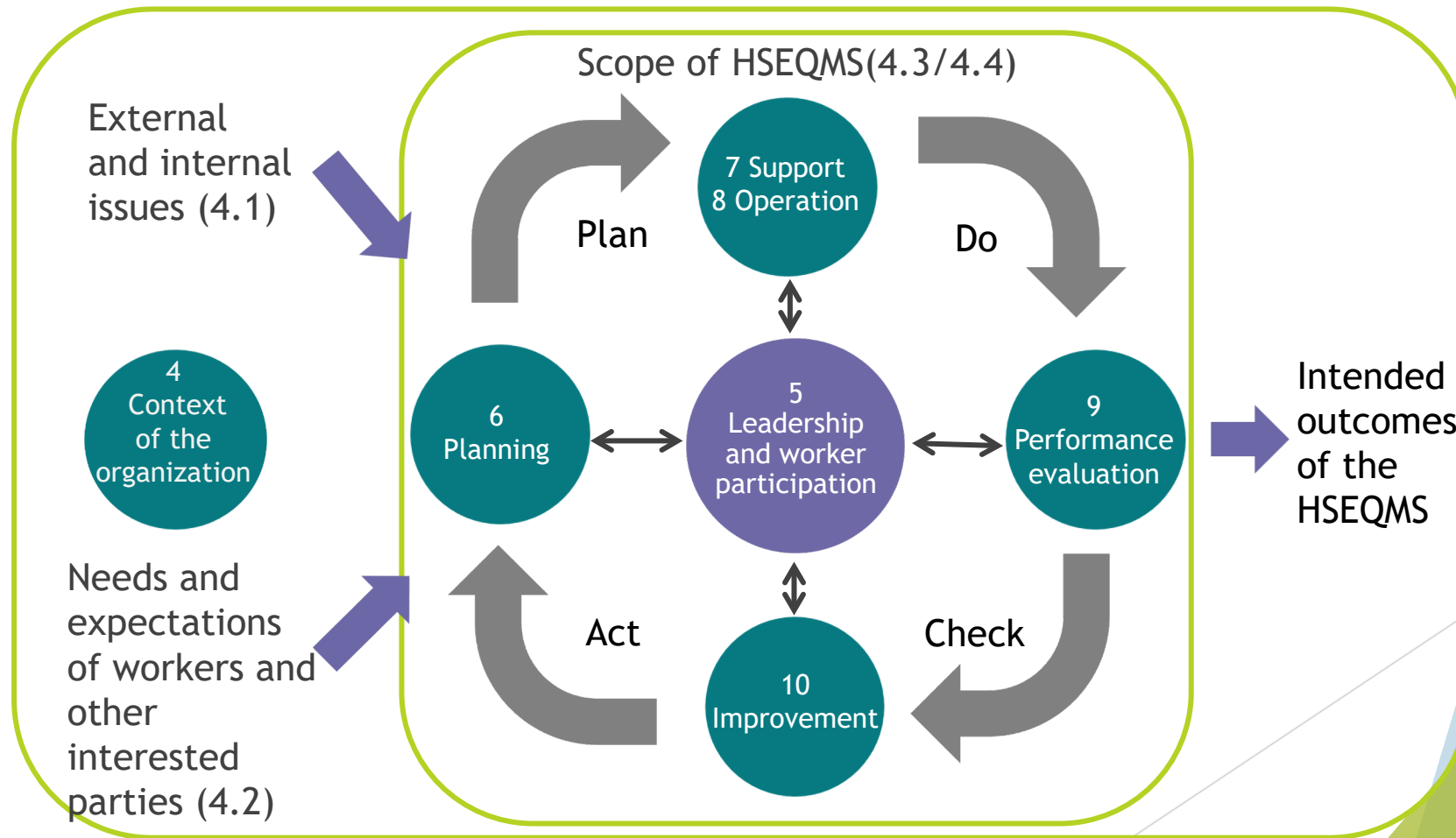


HSEQ Training Module 1 - HSEQ Management System Overview Presentation

THE PLAN, DO, CHECK, ACT APPROACH

Based up the Plan, Do, Check, Act approach, the integrated HSEQ management system structure is outlined below:



Quality Management

- ISO 9001 is for **quality management**.
- **Quality** refers to all those features of a product (or service) which are required by the customer.
- **Quality management** means what the organization does to
- Ensure that its products or services satisfy the customer's **quality requirements** and
- Comply with any **regulations** applicable to those products or services.

Environmental Management

ISO 14001 is for **environmental management**. This means what the organization does to:

- **Minimize harmful effects** on the environment caused by its activities,
- To conform to applicable **regulatory requirements**, and to
- Achieve continual improvement of its **environmental performance**.

Health & Safety Management

ISO 45001 is for **occupational health and safety management**. This means what the organization does to:

- Provide a safe and healthy workplace
- Enable H&S to be integrated with other aspects, such as worker wellness/wellbeing.
- Integrate H&S into overall business processes.
- Provide platform for continual improvement.
- Improve H&S performance to provide a safe and healthy workplace.
